ASM Maritime is committed to protecting the environment from all forms and types of pollution caused by company activities. To achieve this objective, ASM Maritime is dedicated to:

- Take all practical steps to safeguard the working environment and ensure the safety of all personnel working in or visiting any vessel or shore facility operated by the Company.
- Set and review environmental and energy objectives and targets
- Reduce of permitted emissions
- Take all reasonable measures to eliminate the risk of pollution and promote a Zero Spill mindset
- Provide adequate resources to meet the set company objectives and targets
- Raise awareness of the environment and energy management amongst personnel
- Improve the company's safety, environmental and energy management figures through continuous improvement process
- Review the suitability of alternative or new technologies, systems or equipment which can enhance safer operations and reduce environmental impact and energy consumption.
- Dispose, handle and control all waste in an environmentally sound manner.
- Consider all environmental consequences when engaging in goods or services from third parties, where practical.
- Provide appropriate training to all personnel whose work may create a significant impact upon safety and environment.
- Ensure compliance with all applicable national and international laws, regulations and other requirements as applicable and identified by the Company.
- Observe and comply with the requirements of the company's Quality & Environmental system (ISO 9001 and ISO 14001), EU MRV, UK MRV, IMO DCS and the IMO's International Safety Management Code;
- Adhere to requirements of International Conference on the Safe and Environmentally Sound Recycling of Ships at all times and in particular in case of scrapping the vessels
- Ensure strict adhering to Ballast Water Management Convention requirements as well as local laws and regulations while operating in territorial waters of non-signatory countries of the Convention [such as US], thus ensuring zero transfer of evasive aquatic species in Company's vessels ballast water discharges.
- Encourage all personnel to report directly or anonymously by mail [env@asm-maritime.com](mailto:env@asm-maritime.com) any suspected MARPOL or Ballast Water Convention violation onboard fleet vessels without fear of retaliation from Company side.
- Make the Company's policy available for public scrutiny.
